STUDENT PORTFOLIO INFORMATION SHEET 2017
[PLEASE READ CAREFULLY - GUIDELINES HAVE CHANGED]

Students who have been nominated for the Summer Honors Program Art Class should develop a portfolio of examples of their own artwork. **Educational Service Unit #11 must RECEIVE these portfolios no later than 5:00 p.m. on Monday, March 6th. NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.**

Guidelines for portfolios of Art nominees:

NEW: Each student should turn in a Cover Sheet with their Art Work that includes the student's name, home address, cell phone, school, and an email address that you consistently use.

Each student nominated must put together a portfolio that should include their **three** best samples of their own unique **2-dimensional** artwork.

All art selections must be original student work from the 2016-2017 school year.

Artwork from any previous Summer Honors Program should not be included.

The Nominee's name, school and home address should appear **ONLY ON THE BACK SIDE OF THE ARTWORK.** It will be acceptable if a student has signed the front of their artwork.

The **judge will examine the three samples of 2-dimensional artwork submitted** and the strongest artwork will be pulled from those three samples. The two remaining samples of artwork in the portfolio will be used if there is a close decision between two students.

The portfolios will be judged on the following criteria: color; line; texture; value; and shape.

The students whose portfolios are judged to be of the highest quality will be selected for the Summer Honors Program.
