

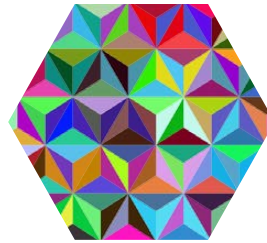
Keynote Josh Erickson

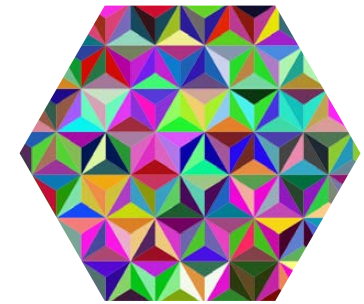
